The New York State United Teachers Member Benefits Plan is pleased to present quality Vision Care Plan benefits for you and your family. To assure you the best possible use of your benefit, please take a few minutes to review the information in this booklet.

### How do I receive services from a provider in the network?

- Call the network provider of your choice and schedule an appointment.
- Identify yourself as a Davis Vision plan participant and a NYSUT member or covered dependent\*.
- Provide the office with the member's ID number and the date of birth of any covered children needing services.

It's that easy! The provider's office will verify your eligibility for services, and no claim forms or ID cards are required!

\* Dependent coverage is available if family coverage was purchased. Dependents are your spouse and dependent children, who include: Natural and legally adopted children, and any other children who permanently reside in your household. Coverage is available until age 19. Coverage will continue until age 25 with appropriate full-time student identification.

### Who are the network providers?

They are licensed providers who are extensively reviewed and credentialed to ensure that stringent standards for quality service are maintained. <input checked="" type="checkbox"/>	<b>CONTACT LENSES</b> .....	Every January 1
	<b>Copayment</b> .....	No copayment applies toward planned supplied standard, soft, daily-wear, disposable*** or planned replacement*** contact lenses in lieu of eyeglasses. A \$100.00 credit will be applied toward contact lenses from the provider's own supply, fitting fees and recommended follow-up care. Prior approval is required for medically necessary contact lenses.

Please note: Contact lenses can be worn by most people. Once the contact lens option is selected and the lenses are fitted, they may not be exchanged for eyeglasses. Routine eye examinations may not include professional services for contact lens evaluations. Any applicable fees are the responsibility of the patient.

\*\* All non-medically necessary materials (frame and/or spectacle / contact lenses) will be reimbursed up to \$35.00. Medically necessary contact lenses will be reimbursed up to \$350.00.

\*\*\* Disposable contact lens wearers will receive a four multi-pack supply of lenses. Planned replacement contact lens wearers will receive a two multi-pack supply.

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## What lenses/coatings are included?

- Plastic or glass single vision, bifocal or trifocal lenses, in any prescription range.
- Glass grey #3 prescription lenses.
- Oversize lenses.
- Post-cataract lenses.
- Fashion, sun or gradient tinted plastic lenses.
- Scratch-resistant coating.
- Photogrey Extra® (photosensitive) glass lenses.
- Polycarbonate lenses.
- Ultraviolet (UV) coating.
- Blended invisible bifocals.
- Intermediate vision lenses.
- Standard and premium progressive addition multifocal lenses.\*

\* Progressive addition multifocals can be worn by most people. Conventional bifocals will be supplied at no additional charge for anyone who is unable to adapt to progressive addition lenses.

## Are there any optional lens types or coatings available?

Yes, you can pay the low, discounted fixed fees indicated and receive these exciting optional items:

- \$35.00 for standard brands of ARC (anti-reflective coating). Premium ARC is \$48.00.
- \$75.00 for polarized lenses.
- \$65.00 for plastic photosensitive lenses.
- \$55.00 for high-index (thinner and lighter) lenses.

## May I use the benefit at different times?

All services must be obtained at one time from either a network or an out-of-network provider.

## When will I receive my eyewear?

Your eyewear will be sent to your provider from the laboratory generally within two to five business days. More delivery time may be needed when out-of-stock frames, ARC (anti-reflective coating), specialized prescriptions or a participating provider's frame is selected.

## What about out-of-network provider benefits?

You may receive services from an out-of-network provider, although you will receive the greatest value and maximize your benefit dollars if you select a provider who participates in the network. If you choose an out-of-network provider, you must pay the provider directly for all charges and then submit a claim for reimbursement to:

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## Continuation of coverage through COBRA (Self-Pay):

In accordance with the provisions of the Consolidated Omnibus Budget Reconciliation Act (COBRA), should your coverage for vision care benefits stop, you and your eligible dependents may be able to continue your vision care benefits pursuant to COBRA.

If your vision care benefits coverage terminates, you must inform immediately the provider of your vision care benefits (your employer, your local union, or your local union's welfare benefit fund) of your desire to continue your vision care coverage pursuant to COBRA.

## Are there any exclusions?

The following items are not covered by this vision program:

- Medical treatment of eye disease or injury.
- Vision therapy.
- Special lens designs or coatings, other than those previously described.
- Non-prescription (plano) lenses.
- Replacement of lost eyewear.
- Two pairs of eyeglasses, in lieu of bifocals.
- Contact lenses and eyeglasses in the same benefit period.
